Location: Paredes de Coura, Portugal.

Date: 1st – 15th, May, 2019 **Participants:** 20-30 (total)

All participants will be working individually or in groups, and will spend the majority of the time in the field, sometimes under harsh conditions using simple documentation tools and techniques.

Available vacancies:

- 10-15 international veterans:

Open to all Vernadoc network elements, with relevant experience in hand drawing survey.

- 5-10 ESG students:

Open to all students of Escola Superior Gallaecia interested in developing their technical drawing skills.

- 5 external participants:

Open to all people interested in developing their technical drawing skills, preferably oriented to architecture, history or heritage conservation students.

Language: Basic English is mandatory

Time Table:

- One week for sketches, measuring and basic drawings.
- One week for manually finishing of the drawings on paper using ink.
- Six working days a week.
- Eight working hours a day.
- 2 Local excursions will be provided by the camp organization.
- The produced drawings will be published and exhibited.
- Final days to assemble the exhibition.
- A set of free hand sketching workshops will be developed in parallel under the guidance of ESG drawing teachers.

Certificate: The participants will be awarded a certificate at the end of the camp.

Accommodation and Subsistence Costs:

All the participants will be provided with a drawing tool kit, lunch and daily transportation from and to the village of *Paredes de Coura*.

Local accommodation and dinner will be also provided to all the *international veterans* during the camp. Travel expenses to and from *Paredes de Coura* will not be included.

Accommodation and dinner is not provided to the rest of the *applicants* (ESG students or external applicants).
