

Daniel Casas-Valle

Daniel Casas-Valle is an urbanist - urban designer, planner and researcher - with a broad experience based on urban planning practices and academic activities. He is 20 years connected to urbanism, as a designer and researcher. Currently, he is working at various projects at his office Urban Dynamics and at the MDT/CEAU/FAUP as a researcher. For the last years, he also was an invited assistant professor on 'public space design' at the Architecture School of University of Minho (PT) and 'urbanism' at the Architecture School of Vila Nova de Cerveira (PT). Casas Valle holds a master on urbanism (Amsterdam, NL) and, in 2018, he finished his PhD at the Faculty of Architecture, Porto University. His main focus on research is: The Future Design of Streets (public space, mobility, streets, technology, adaptation, flexibility); Design and planning of spaces for sport, physical activities and playing; and Urban transformation at various scales.

Daniel Casas Valle graduated in Townplanning (1997), Hogeschool van Utrecht, and obtained a Master degree in Urbanism, Academy of Architecture Amsterdam (2002). His final project was awarded with a honorable mention by Archiprix 2002. In the period 1997-2010 he worked in the planning practice as lead designer and planner in several organisations as: the Amsterdam municipality, Must urbanism and the Architecten Cie.. During this period, he was involved in several urban projects that includes street and public space design, at various scale and planning levels. He did his PhD research in Architecture (Cum Laude) at the Faculdade de Arquitetura da Universidade do Porto (Dinâmicas e Formas Urbanas; 2010-2018). Last years, Daniel combined various education activities as invited assistant professor at the Universidade do Minho, Escola de Arquitectura, Guimarães and at the Escola Superior Gallaecia, Vila Nova de Cerveira, with several urban studies and design projects for public entities, also on street and public space design.

The scientific area of Daniel is architecture and urbanism, design and planning. His scientific career is linked with the recent completed PhD research "Streets & Urbanisation". In recent years, he has published more than 20 papers, which 8 on peer reviewed conferences, and did supervise as co-supervisor three master students.

Daniel always looked for exchanging knowledge and establishing contacts and collaborations by participating in international and national conferences, as well as giving lectures at several universities. At the FAUP, he is frequently invited as visiting critic for the 5th year students' projects (master). He is also interested in transmitting and sharing his knowledge to a broad spectrum of society, including municipalities, on public debates and within professional platforms. Examples of such activities were, the organisation and tutoring of: the course "Territórios Informais: Direitos, Legitimidade e Cidadania" MDT-CEAU-FAUP + ICS-U Lisboa (8-11 May 2017); the workshop "Ensaio para uma metodologia de avaliação do valor de serviço do sistema de espaço público", PSSS (public space's service system: an integrated assessment methodology; Porto 9-12 November 2017); the Summer workshop "The Big Reset on Neighbourhood Design, Design in Urbanism" (Porto 27 July-5 August 2016; coordination).

In the period of 2002-2010, Daniel frequently was involved with the education program of the Academy of Architecture, Amsterdam. As tutor/professor he led several design studios and workshops, gave lecturers and urban history classes, and was member of juries. In 2008-2010 he was the semester coordinator (Plan Zuid). In parallel and before his scientific path, Daniel was involved with several projects that have the character of 'practical-based-research' (other research), as: 'Small Urbanism' (2010-2012), 'Sport in the City' (2010-2013), 'The Limes Atlas' (2005) and 'Hybride Landscape' (2004).
